In contrast to previous generations, our communities have seen a significant increase in students driven to school - a national trend. Defined projects in Southern, Central and Northern Marin within built up cities and towns can demonstrate how all weather pathways might relieve school traffic - a source of major congestion. Opportunities for multi-use pathways and connectors to maximize walking and biking should be identified, coordinated with the Safe Routes to Schools Program. Our goal should be to strive for maximum public benefit by emphasizing multi-use pathways which, where possible, are handicapped accessible - keyed to peak weekday travel times in our established communities.
