## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This study looked at feasible, safe, and efficient east-west bikeway alignments from the western limit of Fairfax to downtown San Rafael, analyzing options in this constrained corridor, including San Rafael's West End, Miracle Mile, San Anselmo Hub, Center Boulevard, and Broadway. Both corridor and intersection improvements were considered. This corridor is one of the key east-west bicycle and pedestrian routes in the county and is constrained by existing development patterns and narrow roadways. The Town of Fairfax was the lead for the study with participation by staff and stakeholder groups from San Anselmo and San Rafael.

## STATUS

The final study was released in March, 2010 and presented to the town councils of Fairfax and San Anselmo in May. It identifies short- and medium-term projects throughout the corridor. The report provides a means for the communities to be competitive for grants to proceed with projects with which they choose to undertake.
