PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This study will examine ways to improve bicycle, pedestrian, and vehicular circulation and safety around the Parkade in Downtown Fairfax. The Parkade area is centered on the parking lot bounded by Broadway Avenue, Sir Francis Drake Boulevard, Claus Drive and Pacheco Avenue. The study will focus on improving pedestrian and bicycle safety and accommodation along existing facilities, as well as proposing new and improved walkways, crosswalks, bikeways and bike parking as needed. Pedestrian and bicycle access to the transit stop in the Parkade will be an important component as well as completing the East-West Bikeway through downtown. Improvements to the sometimes complex motor vehicle circulation may be necessary. This study follows the redesign and reconstruction of the contiguous segment of Center Boulevard, construction of which is to be completed in 2008, and which includes widened sidewalks, improved crosswalks and new bicycle lanes.
